The Peninsula Tenants Committee plays an important role in the way PHA is run and influences policy-forming through representation on sub-committees, working groups and through our consultation panel system.

There are now 23 members on the committee from across Cornwall with elected representatives from across our neighbourhoods.

The committee meets 5 times a year and provides an opportunity for tenants to give their views about how policy and governance issues may affect them and the other organisations and agencies they are involved with.
