Over 21% of residents voted and the successful candidates were Frank Bowater 191 votes (St Ives), Winnie Chappell 206 votes (St Erth), Ken Eaton 178 votes (St Ives), Norman Emberson 176 votes (Hayle), Rose Perkin 186 votes (Carbis Bay), Tracey Retter 175 votes (Hayle), Ted Taylor 210 votes (St Erth).
